Oaks class have made a start on weeding and tidying kitchen garden. We hope to start planting seeds soon and seeing what will grow.










(Virtual) Assemblies are back

These assemblies are shared in school via Google Classroom where pupils watch a prerecorded video of their peers. Well done Oaks - a fantastic effort!










Tiny visitors
