

Welcome back everyone! It has been fantastic to see you all settling well into a new term and enjoying spending time with other classes again.

We have enjoyed hearing about the interesting things you have done over the summer break and look forward to seeing you learning new things over the coming weeks.









This year we have introduced knowledge organisers for each of our foundation subjects to give our pupils some insight into our new topics. Here are some good examples completed by Oaks.




