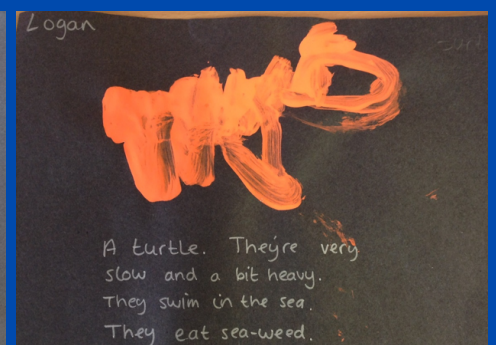
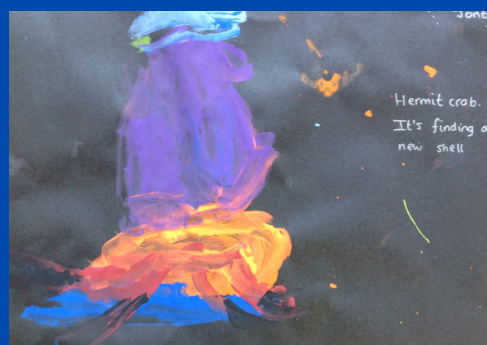
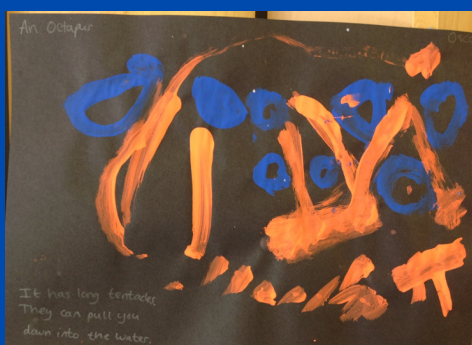
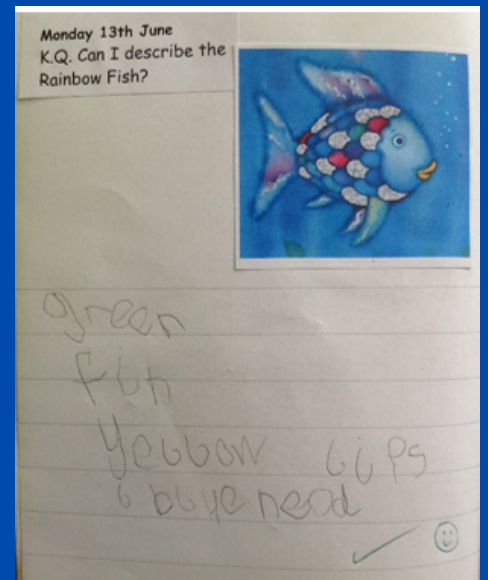
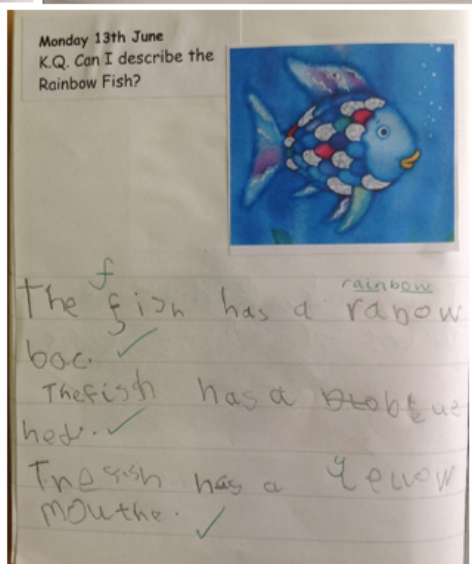
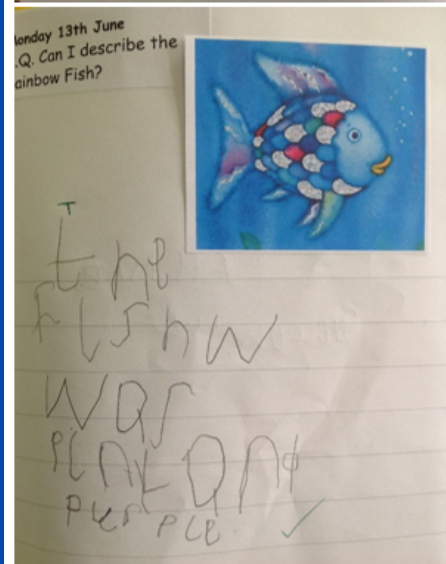
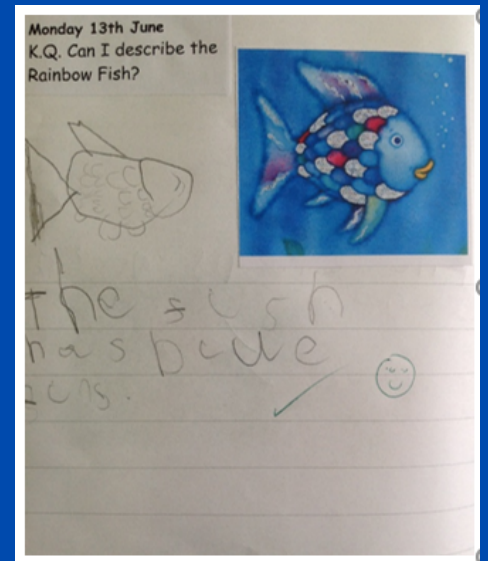
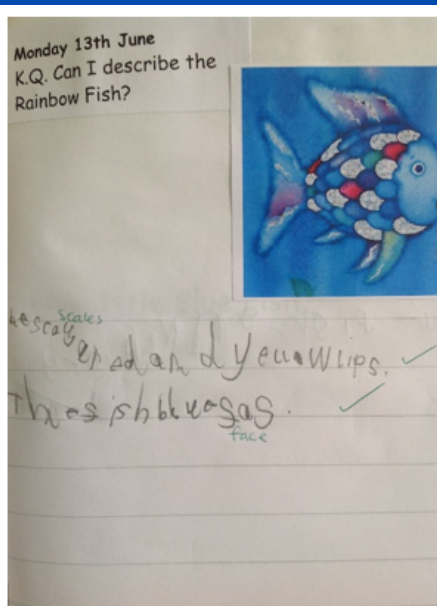
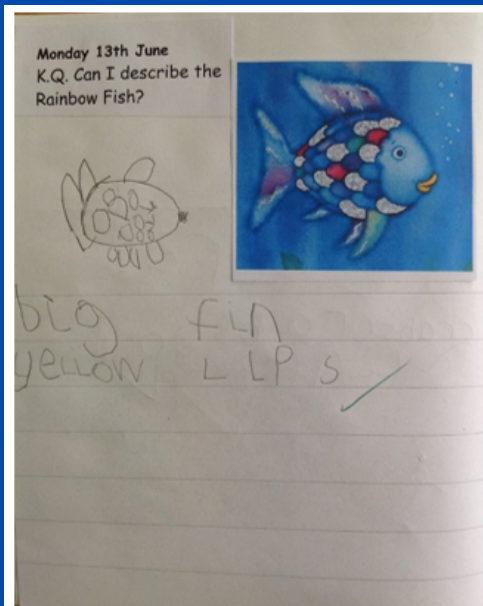




# Under the Sea

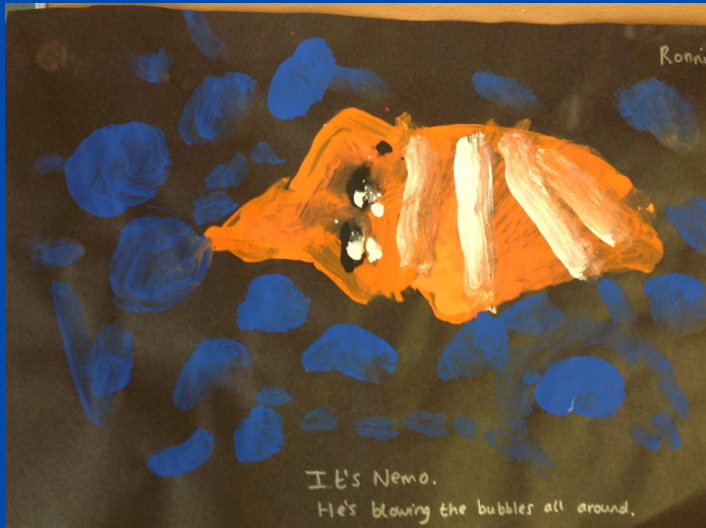

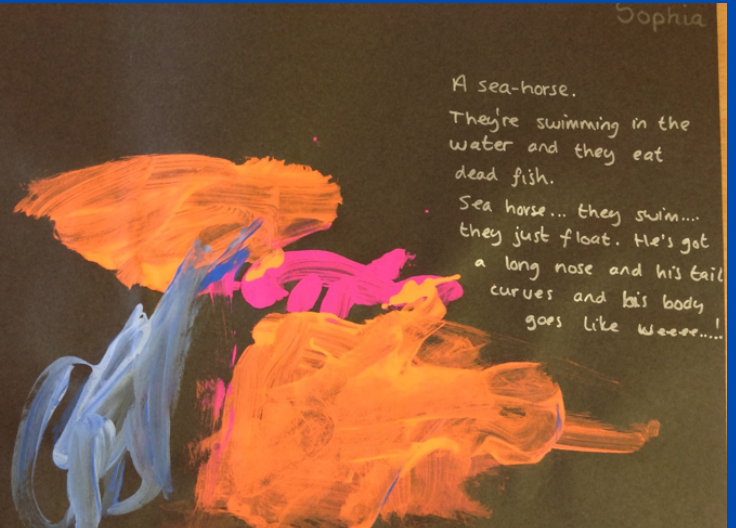

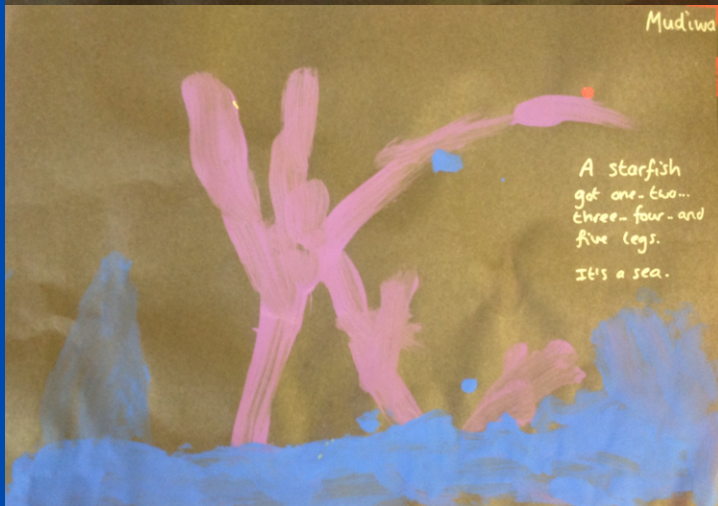
Ronni

# On the Farm

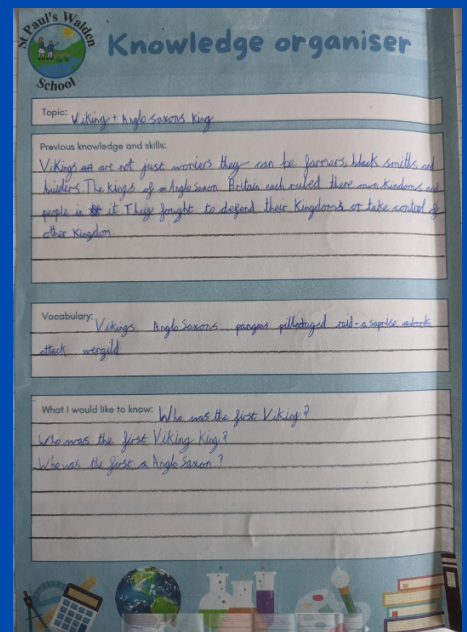
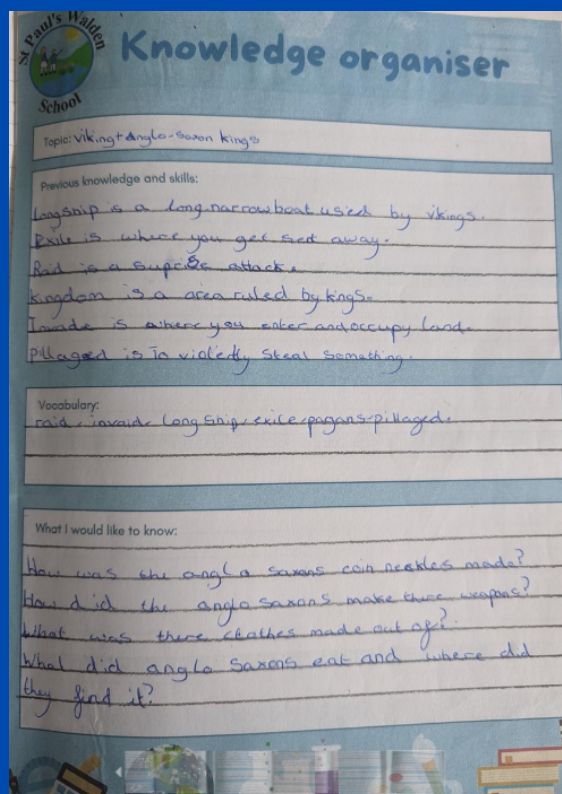
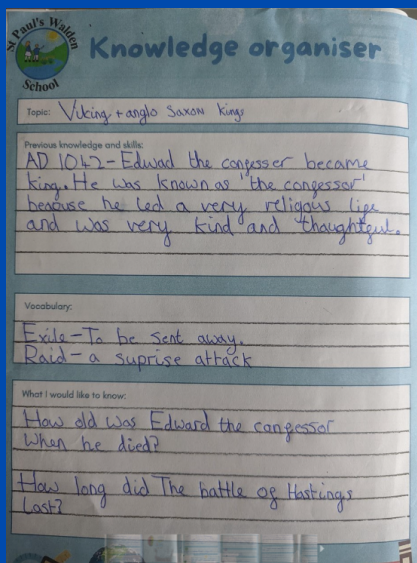
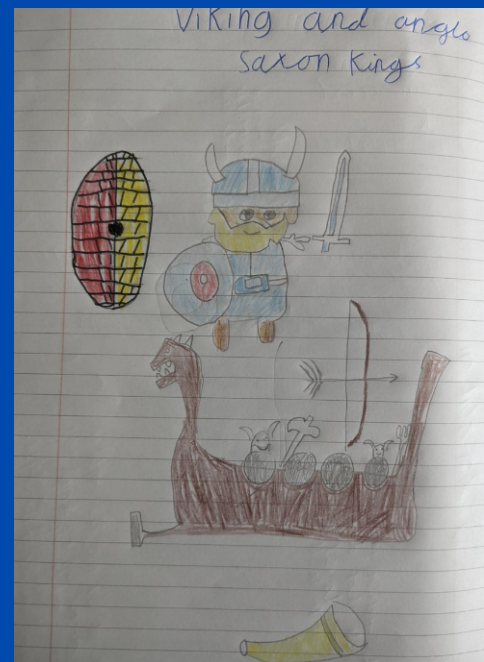
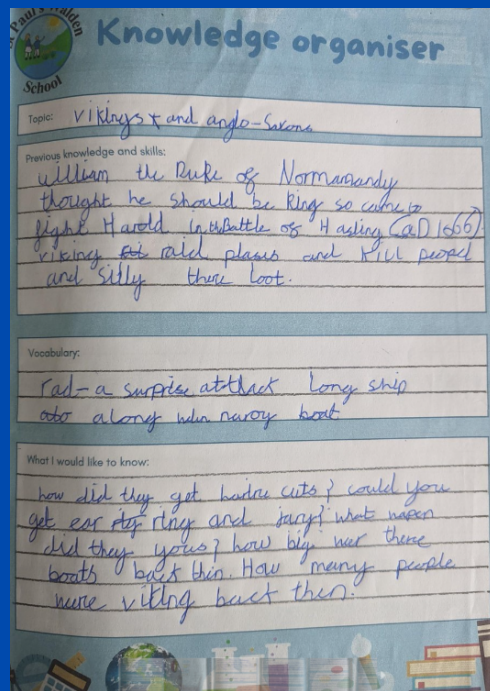
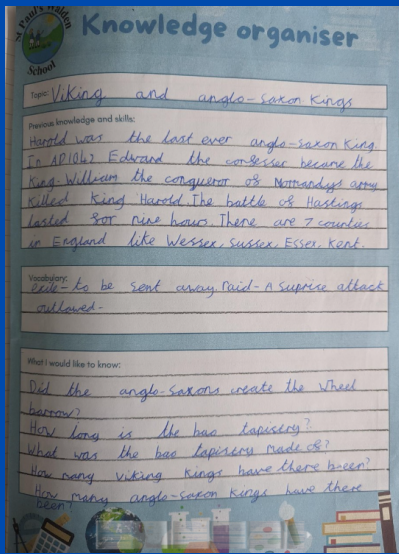
The Rowans had a fantastic time at the farm this week. We saw cattle up close! We also got to see hay being cut and even got a ride on the tractor!
