...and safely under the covers.



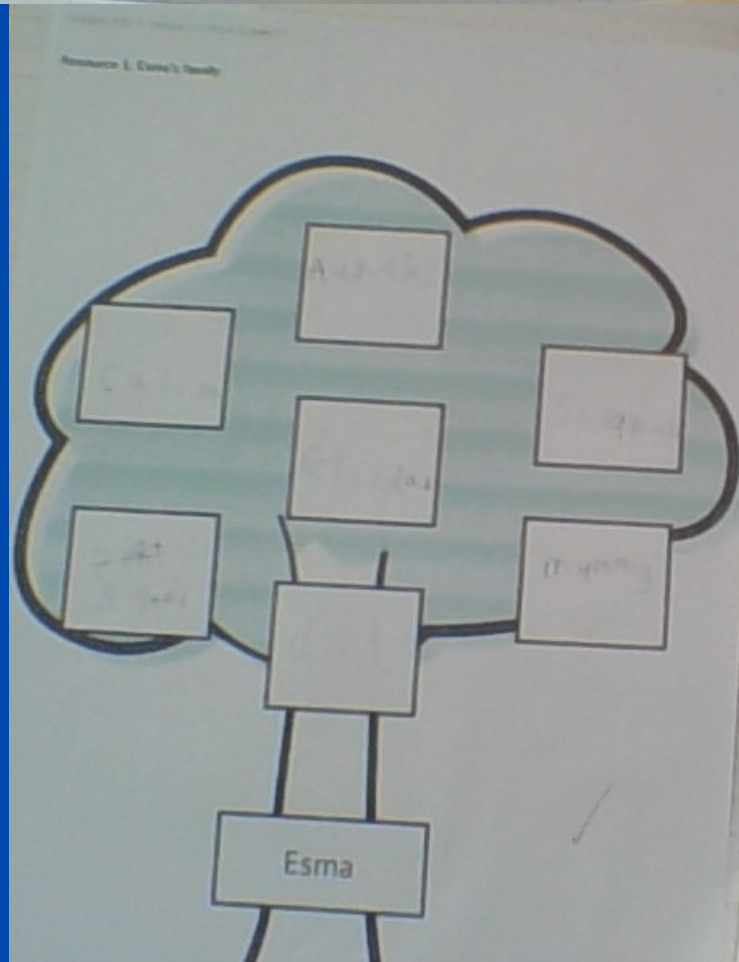
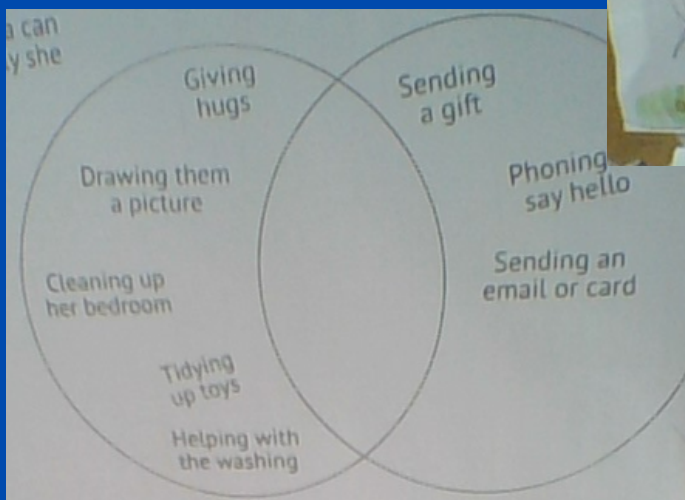
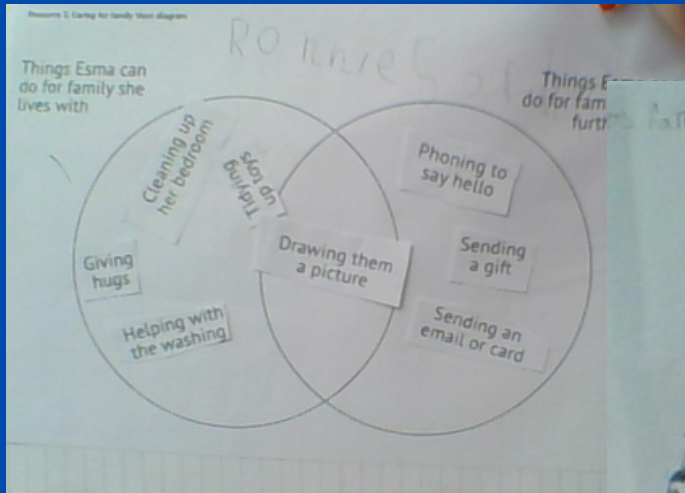

Rowans have been learning about important people in their lives. They have discussed what it is to be a family and different variations of how this looks for different people.

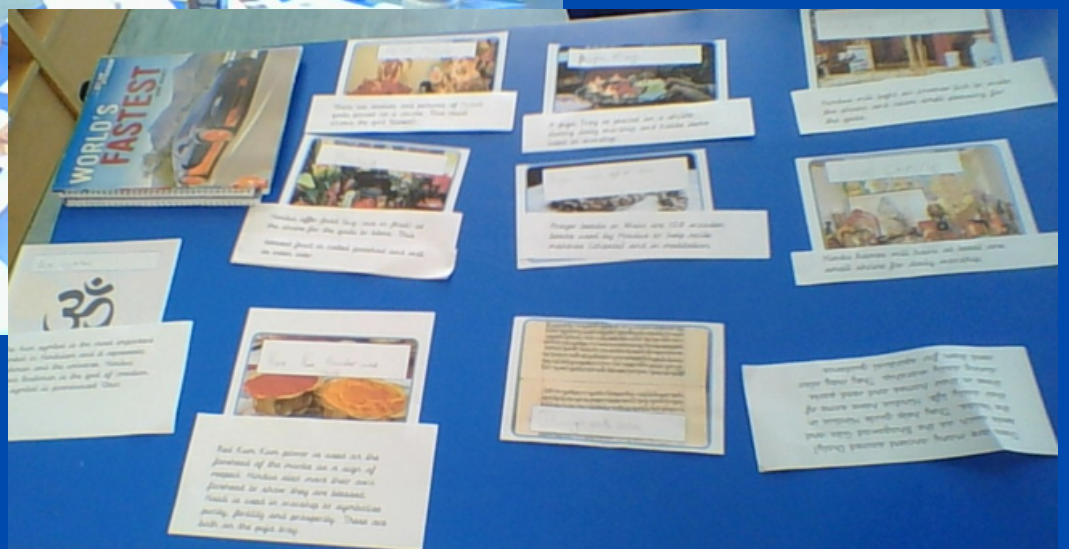
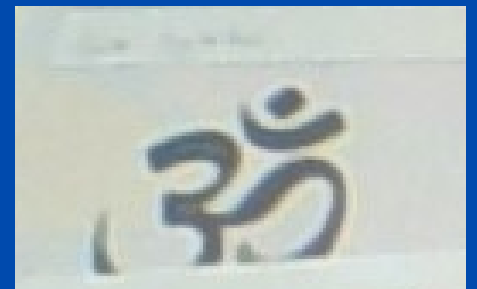
Here is some of their work from PSHE this week.

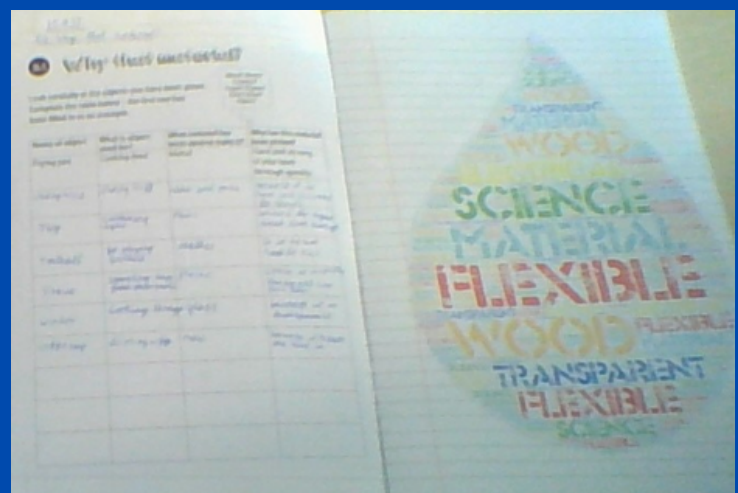
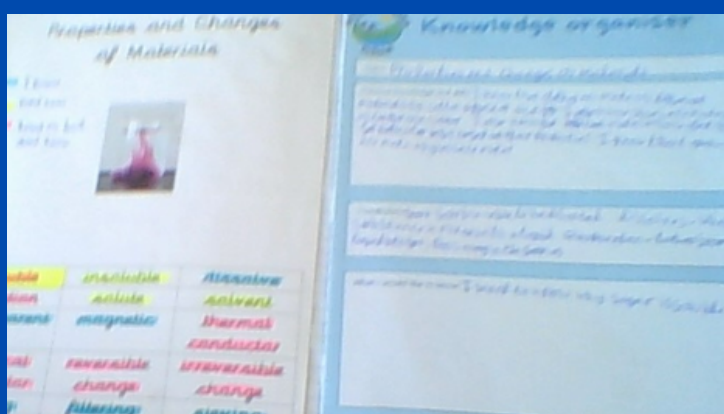
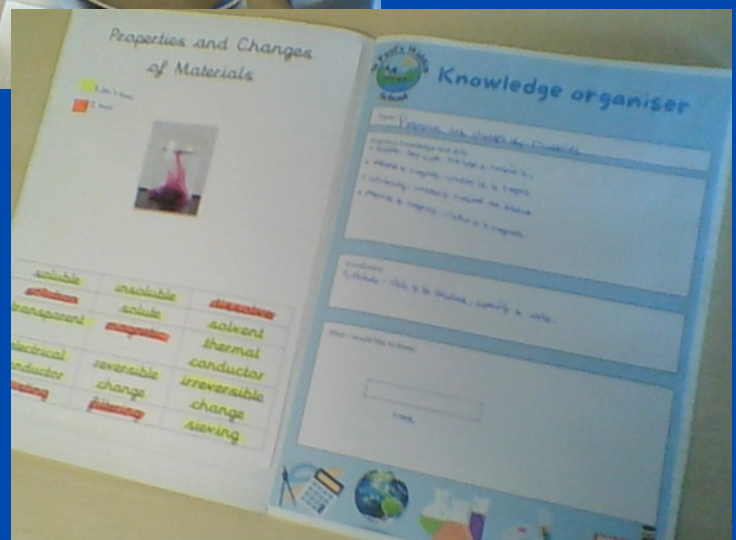
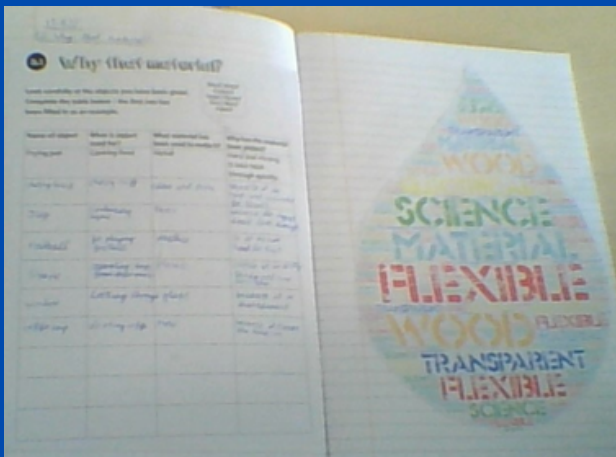
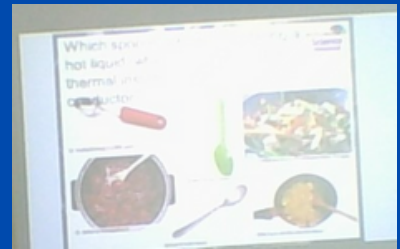




# Working Scientifically
