
I am pleased to announce that we are running another art competition. I am sure that there will be some great prizes! All that we ask is that the children complete the entry themselves.


LEARNING IN THE WILLOWS

In Willows we have recently been learning about rhythms in music. We have been practising different basic rhythms by clapping and using simple percussion instruments to get used to counting and hearing the beat. This week, we had a go at the djembe drums and we practised a specific rhythm. It was quite tricky but it helped when we used syllables from our names, such as 'Abigail - Petar' 'Isobel - Lilly'. Someone suggested 'Abigail - Max' but we discovered that it didn't play all the notes. However, it worked when it was changed to 'Abigail - and Max'. We also learned about changing the volume, as we played loudly or softly as directed. Generally, the class preferred to play loudly! We are looking forward to playing the drums again.



LEARNING IN THE SILVER BIRCHES

In Science this week, the Silver Birches have been busy investigating magnets. They've been using them to see which objects are magnetic and which are not. They then looked at how magnets could be different strengths and created their own investigations to see how many paperclips different magnets could pick up. Some were quite shocked by how many the big magnet could pick up!
