KS2 pupils will be swimming next term, again we need to have your consent prior to taking your child swimming. Should you have any questions or need support with payments please contact the school office.


Thank you to all the parents who attended our parent consultations. If you were unable to attend and would like to discuss your child's progress, then please contact the school office to book an appointment.

LEARNING IN THE WILLOWS

The Willows class have been looking at spiders this week, and have been reading the book Aaaaarrgghh Spider! by Lydia Monks. They have made their own spider puppets independently, by looking at a model and working out ways to fix the stick onto the body. Some of the children decided to make their own spider webs, and found the best way to do this was to cut out a large hole in card, punch or pierce holes around the edge and weave the white wool through the holes in the same pattern that they can see in real webs. Maths learning included counting out spiders from the web and matching them to the numbers, and they have been introduced to Mrs Foster's favourite song, Nasty Spider, which they are thoroughly enjoying learning.

























LEARNING IN THE ROWANS
